



What is "Batik"?

"Batik" is a traditional wax and dye process from **Ghana**. Below are the **4 main steps** to creating batik:



1. First a **stamp** is created out of foam.



2. "Foams" are dipped in melted **wax** and pressed onto the fabric.



3. The fabric is **dyed** one or more colors. Then it is **boiled** in hot water to remove the wax.



4. The fabric is laid in the sun to **dry**. Then it is **boxed** up and shipped to you!
